Summary of Content

Updates to DME Rulebook to permit block trades for DME Brent Crude Oil Financial Contract (ZO) & DME Oman Crude Oil Financial Contract (ZG)

Dubai Mercantile Exchange Limited ("DME" or the "Exchange") wishes to announce that Rule 6.31, "Block Trades," has been expanded to allow the submission of Block Trades in the DME Brent Crude Oil Financial Contract (ZO) and the DME Oman Crude Oil Financial Contract (ZG), once trading in these contracts commences on anticipated trade date 2 June 2008. The amendment to Rule 6.31(I), which has been approved by the Dubai Financial Services Authority, will allow for the submission of a Block Trade with a minimum quantity of 100 lots in the above noted futures contracts via the NYMEX ClearPort® Clearing ("CPC") Trade Entry Portal, or to the NYMEX Facilitation Desk ("NFD").

Rule 6.31 has been amended as follows, with new provisions marked:

- (I) Block Trades shall be permitted in accordance with this Rule 6.31 in the following Exchange products or otherwise with the prior approval of the DFSA under the conditions described:
- 1) DME Oman Crude Oil futures contracts, for a threshold minimum quantity of 100 contracts.
 - 2) DME Brent Crude Oil Financial Contracts, for a threshold minimum quantity of 100 contracts
 - 3) DME Oman Crude Oil Financial Contracts, for a threshold minimum quantity of 100 contracts
